

Medical Education Affiliated Staff Scholarship Terms and conditions

Established in 2009 by the Faculty of Medicine to encourage affiliated staff who regularly teach in the MBBS to undertake studies in Medical Education.

The scholarships are awarded under the following conditions:

1. The scholarship shall be known as the "Medical Education Affiliated Staff Scholarship".
2. Up to four scholarships will be awarded each year, depending on the number of suitable applicants and available funding.
3. The scholarship will be awarded by the Dean of the Faculty of Medicine on the recommendation of a selection committee chaired by the Heads of the Offices of both Medical and Postgraduate Medical Education, to Faculty of Medicine staff including clinical title holders, who teach in the MBBS and enrol in one of the Graduate Certificate, Graduate Diploma or Master of Medical Education.
4. The scholarship will cover a portion of the fees of successfully completed units of study relating to education taken within the University of Sydney for the duration of the course. The amount covered will be 50% of local fees or the fee paid, whichever is the lesser amount.
5. The scholarship will be paid as a reimbursement of 50% of the fees following successful completion of each unit.
6. The scholarship is tenable for the duration of the course conditional upon satisfactory progress.
7. Recipients who commence a lower level course will have the scholarship extended if they are permitted to transfer to a higher level course within the Medical Education program.
8. The scholarship is not transferrable to any other program within the University of Sydney or to any other institution.
9. The scholarship may be held in conjunction with other scholarships.
10. The Faculty of Medicine has the discretion not to award any scholarships if there are no appropriate applicants.
